

ABCs of Salvation and Holy Living

(A)dmitt that you have sinned and need a Saviour; confess and repent (Romans 3:10; 10:8-13; 1 John 1:8-9)

(B)elieve & receive Jesus as the one & only needed Lord & Saviour becoming a member of his church, universally & locally (John 3:16; Matt 16:18).

(C)ongregate/Collaborate regularly with family in the home and outside the home with others at designated times of faithful worship expressing love for God, self, and others (Lev 23:3; Heb 10:25; Matt 22:34-40; 1 Tim 3:15-16).

(D)o what God called and gifted you to do; be a holy influence and example in faith, thoughts, words, deeds and unity based on God's truth. Exhort others to come to God through the **right faith** in Jesus Christ by the Holy Spirit; desire for you and for all to arrive in cool Heaven for eternal life, not hot Hell for eternal death. (Matt 5:13-16; John 14:15; 17:16-23; Rev 20:12-13; 21:1-8).

Protocol

Let all things be done decently & in order. Considering historical & modern church & societal controversies & technologies, clarity is essential.

Recognize sanctuary as a sacred place. Watch phone use. Please limit devotion & invitation periods to max of 10 minutes, it's not sermon time.

Congregation Level Pastoral Ministry & Deacons are restricted to biological males and Women Level Pastoral Ministry to biological females. Both men and women ministers may occupy and speak from the pulpit/platform; but women shall not have any preaching/teaching or other **spiritual authority positionally or priority-wise** over any adult male in the congregation. Leadership like membership is not restricted to any race, ethnicity or nationality. Let all be doctrinally humble and bold in the Lord and the power of his might.

Remember saved sanctified filled with the Holy Spirit believers are at various levels of spiritual maturity; let prayer & patience prevail in considering all you hear/see. God will judge us all now & eternally as mild or severe as he decides. See church website media section for more detailed information on various concerns & church/societal controversies. This protocol is to be the humble, respectful, and cooperative attitude, voice, and action of pulpit/platform and pew, physically and/or virtually.



6. Lift up the poor, oppressed & other marginalized. Meet their needs and break cycles of hardship. Stir hearts toward generosity & justice that all share in the blessings of your provision & protection. We pray to the Lord.

7. Bless the children, other young, and elderly to grow in faith, prayer, wisdom, purpose & success. Bless all to be honored, strengthened, and filled with dignity and peace. Bless all according to the righteous desires and needs for our respective stage of life. We pray to the Lord.

8. We lift up every part of our lives: homes, churches, schools, businesses, governments, and communities to your loving care. We pray to the Lord.

9. Bless our homes to be fruitful places of love, peace, joy, happiness, safety. May families walk in faith, hope, forgiveness, & unity, honoring you as Bible says: as for me & my house we'll serve the Lord. We pray to the Lord.

10. Strengthen our churches, that they may shine as beacons of salvation, worship, relationship, discipleship, and fellowship. As we surrender to your Holy Spirit, help us to exemplify love, faith, hope, grace, mercy, and truth. Fill us with care, concern, and compassion for all. We pray to the Lord.

11 Guide our communities; help neighbors live together in love, respect, justice, and kindness. Let gender, racial, ethnicity, nationality, and class division give way to harmony, fear give way to trust. We pray to the Lord.
